This issue's Geocache is located in Rogue River Park in Belmont. It features a well groomed interactive trail. This is a challenging multi-cache, which means one find will give you a clue to the next. The creator of the cache notes, "The first three stages each contain the coordinates to the next stage AND one of three clues you will need in order to solve the location of the Cache. If you're looking for that telltale pile of sticks you will be disappointed. There ARE containers for each stage just not the usual Ammo Cans, Tupperware, Film Containers You will also need a pencil and paper."

Use coordinates: N 43° 04.737 W
085° 35.862

Ample parking is available at N43° 04.707 W85° 36.355, which also serves as trailhead for the White Pine State Park Trail; or N43° 04.609 W85° 36.223 (which includes picnic and playground areas). The trail starts between the restroom and pavilion.
